STICKY MICKEY, LATE HARVEST SAUVIGNON BLANC, NEW ZEALAND

This hilariously named sweetie has the most raucous orange blossom notes on the nose and a slippery, syrupy palate. Made in tiny quantities this is a wine boffin's dream date.

CORNEY & BARROW 20 YEAR OLD TAWNY PORT

The wine is a tawny/amber in colour, with a complex nose of warming fruit, complemented by hints of orange, nuts and spice, all reflected on the palate. Delightfully fresh, this is particularly versatile with food, particularly served slightly chilled.
